Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has enhanced the Central Assistance for Border Area Development Programmes (BADP);
- (b) if so, the details of the funds allocated under BADP during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of modern villages created/proposals submitted by State Governments under the programme and the funds allocated thereunder, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a): The budgetary allocation under Border Area Development Programme (BADP) for the previous financial year 2016-17 was Rs. 990.00 crore. The budgetary allocation for the current financial year 2017-18 is Rs.1100.00 crore, which is Rs.110.00 crore more than the previous financial year allocation.

(b): The details of funds allocated/released to the State Governments under BADP for the last three years and the current financial year are as under:
