Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state :-

- (a) how many and which are the cases of acts of terror being investigated by National Investigation Agency (NIA);
- (b) in how many and which cases challan has been filed in the Court;
- (c) names of the accused; and
- (d) what are reasons that challan has not been filed in other cases?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI HANSRAJ GANGARAM AHIR)

(a) to (d): The Central Government has entrusted 163 cases to the National Investigation Agency (NIA) for investigation till date, in accordance with Section 6 of the National Investigation Agency Act, 2008. Out of these 163 cases, 153 cases are related to acts of terror. Out of these 153 cases, chargesheets have been filed in 122 cases against 897 accused persons. Out of the remaining 31 cases, 22 cases are under investigation, 1 case has been transferred to the State Police and in 8 cases closure reports have been filed.
