Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is now contemplating to invoke stringent provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA), 1967 against those involved in a drug syndicate operating from Jammu and Kashmir;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that the drug law enforcement agencies across the western region flagged off their concerns at a recent security review; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b): Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA), 1967 extends to whole of India including Jammu & Kashmir. This Act, inter alia, deals with terrorist acts, proceeds of terrorism, terrorist organizations and individuals involved in unlawful activities.
- (c) & (d): The issue of drug trafficking continues to be a serious concern.
