**Police hospitals in naxal affected States**

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state :-

(a) whether Government proposes to establish police hospitals on the lines of army hospitals in naxalite affected States of the country including Chhattisgarh;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the State-wise and union territory-wise details of the amount allocated to other States of the country including Chhattisgarh by Government in this regard?

(a) to (c): There is no proposal for establishment of police hospitals by the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) on the lines of army hospitals in naxalite affected States. However, in CAPFs at primary level, 10/20 bed MI rooms are available in battalions, training centres, etc. In addition, there are 32 Nos. 50 bedded and 06 Nos. 100 bedded Composite Hospitals are available in CAPFs.
