(a) & (b) As on date, no pilot project is operational along the Indo-Pakistan Border in Punjab. However, tender for one pilot project of Comprehensive Integrated Border Management System (CIBMS) in two sensitive patches of 5 to 6 Kms of Jammu Frontier was floated by Border Security Force (BSF) and work in two patches has been awarded. Based on the price of sensors and system integration discovered after opening the financial bids for Jammu Pilot Project, BSF has prepared proposals for Pilot Project of CIBMS for Punjab and Gujarat.
