(a) how Government provides training to paramilitary forces, force-wise;

(b) whether 100 per cent of existing training facilities are being utilised by every force; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor and whether Government would think of having one training facility for all the paramilitary forces for optimum utilization of training facilities? ANSWER

(a) to (c): All Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) i.e. Border Security Force (BSF), Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB), Indian Tibetan Border Police (ITBP), Assam Rifles etc. have their own training institutes with adequate facilities to impart various types of training to their personnel. They impart basic, pre-promotional, in-service, specialized trainings etc. for their personnel in these institutes.

The facilities available with the CAPFs are adequately utilized and these facilities are shared on need basis.
