Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state :-

(a) whether Government is aware of the fact that border between India and Myanmar is extremely porous due to which there is free movement of militants, illegal arms and drugs;

(b) the steps taken by Government in this regard;

(c) whether Government undertook any survey to identify such porous borders with its neighbouring countries; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) to (d) : India shares a porous border with Myanmar. Assam Rifles, the Border Guarding Force on Indo-Myanmar Border, has adopted multipronged approach to curb free movement of militants, illegal arms and drugs by patrolling, sharing of intelligence and conduct of joint operations, liaison with police, intelligence agencies & local government agencies and using surveillance equipments. Survey to identify porous stretch along the borders with neighbouring countries is carried out regularly.
