3216. SHRI PALVAI GOVARDHAN REDDY:

(a) in what manner India looks at Russia, Pakistan and China coming closer and closer;

(b) whether it is because of India moving towards the United States of America (USA); and

(c) what would be the result of newer combinations and how India is planning to go ahead with formation of such new group?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]

(a) to (c) Government of India as a matter of policy does not comment on third country relationships. It pursues an independent foreign policy driven by India's national interests. Government keeps a constant watch on all developments having a bearing on India's security and takes all necessary measures to safeguard its interests.
