India-Russia Bilateral Consultations on Disarmament and Non-Proliferation

March 27, 2017

Mr. Mikhail Ulyanov, Head of the Department of Non-Proliferation and Arms Control, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation visited India on March 23-24, 2017 for the annual round of bilateral consultations on disarmament and non-proliferation, which take place alternately in Delhi and Moscow. Dr. Pankaj Sharma, Joint Secretary (Disarmament and International Security Affairs), Ministry of External Affairs led the Indian delegation.

The consultations covered a broad spectrum of related issues on the international agenda including nuclear and WMD terrorism, nuclear energy.

As part of the series of events to commemorate 70 years of India-Russia Diplomatic Relations, Mr. Ulyanov also delivered a lecture at the Foreign Service Institute, New Delhi on 23 March 2017 on the theme of 'India-Russia Partnership and Prospects for Non-Proliferation and Arms Control'.
