RAIL/ROAD LINK TO IRAN

3906. SHRI BAIJAYANT JAY PANDA:

Will the Minister of External Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to construct a rail/road link to Iran;
- (b) if so, the facts and details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is also planning to use the Iranian port of Chabahar for establishing connectivity to Afghanistan, Uzbekistan and Tajikistan;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of benefits likely to be derived out of such a move along with the time by which constructive steps likely to be taken in this regard?

## **ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]

- (a) & (b) Currently there are no ongoing road or rail projects in Iran involving participation of Government of India.
- (c) to (e) Government has been holding discussions with the Government of Iran to participate in the upgradation of the Chahbahar Port which could, once it is developed, provide a reliable sea-land access route for India to Afghanistan and countries of the Central Asian region.
