- (a) whether India and Tajikistan have pledged to intensify cooperation against terrorism, if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether both the countries have signed two agreements in areas of culture and skill development, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) Yes, India and Tajikistan have agreed to continue active engagement and cooperation in the fight against terrorism and extremism including under the existing India-Tajikistan Joint Working Group on Counter-Terrorism.

(b) Yes, India and Tajikistan signed two documents in areas of culture and skill development during the recent visit of PM to Tajikistan on 12-

13 July, 2015, as under:

(i) Programme of Cooperation (POC) between Ministries of Culture of India and Tajikistan in the field of Culture for the years 2016-18.

(ii) Exchange of Notes Verbale on setting up of Computer Labs in 37 schools in Tajikistan.
