NON-PAYMENT OF DUES OF MIGRANT WORKERS IN QATAR

2584. SHRI HISHEY LACHUNGPA:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether around 4,000 migrant workers in Qatar were not paid their dues for four months;
- (b) whether these workers have met the Ambassador of India in Qatar; and
- (c) if so, the details in this regard and the efforts made by Government to ensure payment to these migrant workers?

ANSWER

(a) No. No such single complaint involving 4000 migrant workers has been received by the Indian Mission in Qatar. However, complaints have been received about the Indian workers working in M/s ETA Engineering Services.

(b) & (c) The Ambassador has already met the distressed workers of M/s ETA Engineering Services. The matter has been taken up with the employer and Qatari Government authorities by the Mission. They have been assured that all the issues being faced by the workers would be sorted out at the earliest.
