2483. PROF. PREM SINGH CHANDUMAJRA: SHRI BHOLA SINGH:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has sent a delegation to Iraq to trace three Indian people who have gone missing after being kidnapped by IS;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has sought DNA samples from the relatives of missing persons for their identification; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI M.J. AKBAR)

(a) No. There is no information with the Government on three Indian nationals having been kidnapped by the IS in Iraq. (b) to (d) Do not arise.
