AGREEMENTS WITH ISRAEL

1443. SHRI A. K. SELVARAJ:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Israel has sought data from India for boosting measures to counter cyber threats and to revolutionize Indian farm production;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether India has signed four agreements with Israel in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]

- (a) & (b) No such information has been sought by Israel.
- (c) & (d) An MoU on Cyber Security Cooperation between India and Israel was signed on 15 January, 2018 during the visit of Israeli Prime Minister to India. The MoU envisages cooperation in the field of cyber security to develop, promote and expand cooperation in the field of HRD through various platforms and

arrangements such as training programmes, skill development, and simulator based hands-on training. It also envisages collaborating in the field of cyber security resilience, promoting B2B cooperation in cyber security and facilitating industrial summits.
