HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES DURING CIVIL WAR IN SRI LANKA

496. SHRI D. RAJA:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the report of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights Investigation on Sri Lanka calling upon Colombo to establish a special court to try the horrific abuses committed by the authorities and the rebels in the last phase of the country's civil war; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and Government's reaction thereto?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]

(a) & (b) The United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights submitted a report on Sri Lanka on 28 September, 2015 during the 30th Regular Session of Human Rights Council held from 14 September- 2 October, 2015. Subsequent to the submission of the report, a resolution titled 'Promoting reconciliation accountability and human rights in Sri Lanka' was adopted by consensus. India made a statement after the adoption of the resolution (placed at Annexure).
