- (b) if so, whether Government proposes to set up a combo business hub therefor; and
- (c) the details of ongoing bilateral ties and projects with Sri Lanka?

India's development portfolio in Sri Lanka is currently around US \$ 2.6 billion. The ongoing projects encompass various sectors of mutual interest including infrastructure development, housing and shelter, water and sanitation, livelihood, education, research and training, healthcare, industrial development, arts, culture and sports etc.
