## India and Bhutan to strengthen Cooperation in Agriculture and Allied Sectors

India and Bhutan agree to strengthen the strategic cooperation in the field of Agriculture & allied sectors between the two countries. An assurance was given by the Agriculture Minister, Shri Radha Mohan Singh that utmost priority will be accorded by the Government of India to the various proposals which were discussed by the Prime Minister of India during his recent visit to Bhutan to his Bhutanese counterpart Shri Lyonopo Yeshey Dorji, here today.

In his opening address, Shri Radha Mohan Singh laid stress on the warm and neighbourly relationship which the two countries enjoyed, based on shared strategic perspective, transparency, utmost trust and sensitivity to each others' vital interest.
