1671. SHRI PRABHAT JHA: SHRI ARVIND KUMAR SINGH: SHRIMATI KUSUM RAI:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether fifty terrorist training camps are being run in Bangladesh, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether Government has raised the issue of anti-India terrorist training camps being run in Bangladesh with Bangladesh Government, if so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor; and (c) the response of Bangladesh thereto?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI E. AHAMED)

(a) to (c) There are some reports of presence of Indian insurgent groups (IIGs) in Bangladesh. Security related issues, including the alleged presence of IIGs in Bangladesh, have been periodically taken up with the Government of Bangladesh at various political and senior official levels. Government of Bangladesh has stated that its territory would not be allowed to be used for activities inimical to India.
