- (a) whether China has put forward a proposal for building road and rail links between China, Nepal and India as part of an economic corridor;
- (b) whether this issue was discussed during Prime Minister's China visit in May, 2015;
- (c) if so, whether India has approved the plan; and
- (d) what are the strategic implications of the above plan?

(a) to (d) During the visit of Hon'ble Prime Minister to China in May 2015, the Chinese side proposed the China-Nepal-India economic corridor. No specific details for it have been provided by the Chinese side.
