2374. SHRI JITENDRA CHAUDHURY:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether agreements on economic, cultural and bilateral co-operation was signed between India and Bangladesh in January, 2010 and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) the present status of these agreements?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]

- (a) Various agreements were signed during the visit of Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to India in January 2010. These were:
- (i) Agreement on Mutual Legal Assistance on Criminal Matters;
- (ii) Agreement on the Transfer of Sentenced Persons;
- (iii) Agreement on Combating International Terrorism, Organized Crime and Illicit Drug Trafficking;
- (iv) Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation in Power Sector;
- (v) Cultural Exchange Programme.

(b) All these agreements are now operational.
