(a) the reasons for the deterioration of Indo-Nepal relations in the recent past; and(b) the measures taken by Government to rectify the unfortunate fall-out in Indo-Nepal relations?

## ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI M. J. AKBAR)

(a) & (b) There is no deterioration of India's ties with Nepal. India's age-old tieswith Nepal are unique and special, characterized by an open border based on sharedhistory, geography, culture, close people-to-people ties, mutual security and closeeconomic linkages. Two-thirds of Nepal's global trade is with India and over 90% ofNepal's third country import-export transit through India. India is committed tofurther strengthen and expand India-Nepal cooperation through regular bilateralexchanges and development assistance. Our bilateral mechanisms covering the areasof defence and security, trade, power, water resources and border management aremeeting regularly besides the India-Nepal Joint Commission which comprehensivelyreviews the entire gamut of bilateral relations. India continues to extend all assistancein accordance with the aspirations of the people of Nepal, for peace, stability andsocio-economic development of the country.
