RESCUE OF INDIANS FROM KENYA

4203. SHRI K. ASHOK KUMAR:

Will the Minister OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has rescued many Indians from Kenya who were victims of an organised crime syndicate involved in human trafficking;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has shared the details with the respective State Governments so that action can be taken against the agents and the people involved in it, and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (DR) V.K. SINGH (RETD)]

- (a) & (b) Four Indian girls were rescued in October 2016 and three girls in December 2017 from the crime syndicates involved in human trafficking in Kenya.
- (c) & (d) Relevant details have been shared with the Government of Union Territory of Chandigarh and state Governments of Punjab and Maharashtra as well as Delhi Police for action against culprits.
