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(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. A Joint Exercise "Hand-in-Hand" was conducted with China in Pujiang, China from 10 to 23 December, 2018. A total of 130 personnel from each side participated in the Joint Exercise.

(d) & (e): The exercise was based on the theme of "Counter terrorist operations covering joint training cum exercise under UN mandate at sub-unit level". Such engagements promote cooperation on training and help in confidence building between the armed forces of the two countries.
