TALKS WITH MYANMAR ON NSCN(K)

(a) whether the Government is in talks with the Myanmar Government for the surrender of extremist and leader of National Socialist Council of Nagaland-Khaplang (NSCN-K) and if so, the details thereof; and

(b) whether the Government proposes to sign an extradition agreement with the Myanmar Government in light of this issue and if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): Government of India has from time to time raised the issue of presence of extremist leaders, including that of NSCN (K) with the Government of Myanmar. As of now there is no proposal under consideration for signing an extradition treaty with Myanmar.
