- (c) whether this move of China is likely to pose a threat to India by expanding its presence in the Indian Ocean; and
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]

(a) to (d) Government is aware of reports that Government of Maldives has been discussing port infrastructure development with international partners, including China. Government keeps a constant watch on all developments having a bearing on India's security and takes all necessary measures to safeguard it.
