## **BHEL POWER PROJECT IN AFGHANISTAN.**

- (a) and (b): Yes Sir. BHEL have secured a contract for setting up 3x14 MW Hydro Power Plant in Salma, Afghanistan from WAPCOS, India and an order for 230 KV Sub-station in Kabul from Power Grid Corporation of India. The cost of the two projects is around Rs.220 crore.
- (c) The Project work on Salma Hydro Power Project commenced in May, 2006 and is likely to be completed by December 2008. The Project work on Kabul Sub-station commenced in end of February, 2006 and is likely to be completed by May 2008.
