ASSISTANCE TO AFGHANISTAN IN ELECTRONIC MEDIA

(a)-(c) Government of India has extended humanitarian relief and reconstruction assistance to the Interim Administration of Afghanistan. During the visit of H.E. Hamid Karzai to India on 26-27 February, 2002 several areas of bilateral cooperation were identified. These included Health, Education, Information Technology, Industrial development, Public Transport and Training. As part of our commitment to assist Afghanistan, government is also considering proposals for cooperation in other areas, including in electronic media.
