(a)-(c) Government has provided extensive humanitarian, financial and project assistance to Afghan reconstruction in diverse fields, while keeping in mind Afghan felt and priority needs. During the visit of H.E. Hamid Karzai to India on 26-27 February 2002, several areas of bilateral cooperation were identified, including in the field of preservation of heritage structures and museums.
