WORKING OF MSMES IN CHINA

2974. SHRI JANARDAN SINGH SIGRIWAL:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has studied the working of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in China and the role of the Chinese Government therein;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is paying attention to production and Marketing of MSME products on the lines of the Chinese system to help the Indian MSME sector to replicate the success of MSMEs in China;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (e) the details of the schemes being implemented at present for promoting MSMEs in the country, state-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI NITIN GADKARI)

- (a)&(b): The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises has not conducted any specific study on the working of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in China.
- (c) & (d): Government has taken several steps under various programmes/Schemes to enhance the manufacturing/production competitiveness and for marketing of the products of MSMEs. Government has also initiated steps to augment the exports of MSME products.
- (e): The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises implements various schemes and programmes to boost the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) Sector throughout the country. These include the schemes/programmes such as Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI), A Scheme for Promoting Innovation, Rural Industry and Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE), Credit Guarantee Scheme (CGTMSE), Credit linked Capital Subsidy-Technology Upgradation Scheme (CLCS-TUS), National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme (NMCP), Micro & Small Enterprises- Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), National Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Hub (NSSH), Procurement and Marketing Schemes (PMS) etc. National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) under the Ministry of MSME also boost and supports Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) Sector by providing integrated support services encompassing marketing, finance, technology and other services. The Interest Equalization Scheme to promote Export from MSME by providing loan with an interest subvention of 5% for pre and post shipment export credit.
